Perkins Access accessibility consultants thoroughly reviewed Connect for Payers for conformance to the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.1 Level A and Level AA using a variety of manual testing techniques, assistive technologies and the exclusive use of the keyboard to operate Connect for Payers on both Windows and Mac operating systems.


