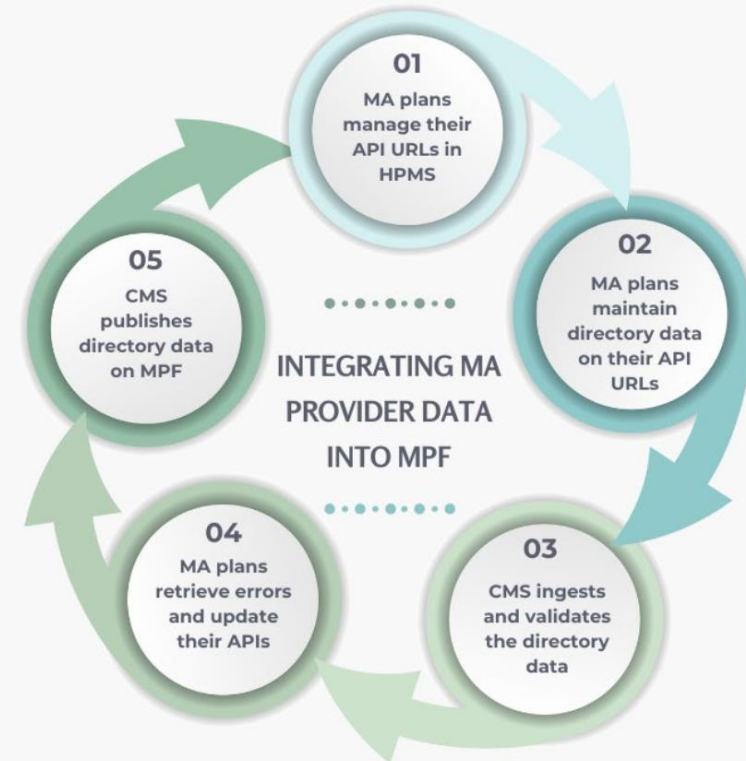

Program Overview

What is Phase 2?

- All payers who offer Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans must supply provider directory data for all individual MA plans to CMS for display in Medicare Plan Finder (MPF) **beginning with Contract Year (CY) 2027.**
- Data will be supplied to CMS, leveraging either **Machine Readable JSON files or FHIR-Based JSON API Files.**
- These files are made available to CMS via a URL defined in a payer's Health Plan Management System (HPMS) Basic Contract Management module which **CMS will crawl and validate the data daily.**
- Plans will be responsible for **ensuring accuracy** of the provider data and must **attest to its accuracy annually.**



Phase 2 Implementation, Timeline and Milestone

Medicare Plan Finder Phase II Implementation

Step 1: Compliance & Resourcing Assessment

Before beginning the technical workstream, determine if your organization is subject to the MPF MA Provider Directory Requirements.

Who must comply?

- Provider directory data must be supplied for all individual (not-employer-only) Medicare Advantage (MA) plans, including:
 - Local Coordinated Care Plans (CCP): HMO, HMO-POS, and Local PPO.
 - Regional PPO Plans.
 - Medical Savings Account (MSA): Network-based plans only.
 - Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS): Network-based plans only.

What resourcing will we need?

- **Primary Technical & Business Contact(s):** Send RevSpring your primary technical and business contact(s) for this work, we will send targeted information and updates to this contact(s).
- **Confirm Participation:** If your organization would be targeting to begin testing in early Q3 notify RevSpring by May 5th, the network crosswalk file sent by May 15th, to be included in Wave 1 (include your technical and business owners).

Medicare Plan Finder Phase II Implementation

Step 2: Technical Requirement Baseline

Establish the data standards needed for a successful Phase II integration.

- **Data Standards:** In order to support Phase II, clients must supply a **Network Crosswalk File**. The file enables RevSpring to filter to and generate the necessary data for compliance
 - **Format:** Pipe-delimited .txt
 - **Naming Convention:** <CLIENT_CODE>_Sunfire_Network_YYYYMMDD.txt
 - **Delivery Location:** AWS or GCP - Include in your provider dataset

Network Crosswalk File

MedicareSegmentID	Alphanumeric	3	The CMS Segment ID. If a Plan is not segmented, submit 000	001

Medicare Plan Finder Phase II Implementation

Step 3: Data Validation & Gap Analysis (May-August)

Validation Check	Action Item
Source of Truth	Use the customer-provided MedicareContractID and NetworkCode to validate all incoming data files.
File Validation	Check the network crosswalk file to ensure compliance with the defined specification, specifically on the distinct values for CMS contract information to prevent data integrity issues
Join Integrity	Ensure the NetworkCode in the crosswalk file matches the provider file exactly.

Medicare Plan Finder Plan Phase II Implementation

Step 4: CMS Submission Readiness

Final verification to ensure file acceptance by CMS.

- **Index File URL(s) Generation:** RevSpring will generate and provide the necessary Index File URL(s) based on CMS standards (per contract ID per Contract Year). Additionally, RevSpring will ensure the index file is accessible to CMS for daily crawls
- **FHIR Based JSON File Compliance:** Files are generated per CMS specifications and make sure they are accessible for download via the Index File.
- **Feedback Loops:** More to come as CMS releases details on the Validation process

Date	Event
November 7, 2025	Publication of draft technical implementation guidance for MA plans
November 7 - December 19, 2025	Review period for industry feedback on the draft technical implementation guidance
February 2, 2026	API URL data entry fields become available in HPMS
February 18, 2026	Publication of updated technical implementation guidance for MA plans
May - August 2026	Plan testing period using machine-readable JSON files and FHIR-based API files
September 1, 2026	Deadline for completing the CY 2027 attestation in HPMS
Early September 2026	Plan preview window
September 18, 2026	"Target" deadline for production-ready CY 2027 data to be available on API URLs
October 1, 2026	Production release of the CY 2027 Medicare Plan Finder (MPF)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Data Requirement Questions

Q: In Phase 1, there was a requirement to include a value for PCP ID. How is this being handled in Phase 2?

A: In Phase 2, the concept of PCP ID that was relevant in Phase 1 is no longer relevant. Identifier that **must be used moving forward will be NPI**.

Q: What data is being transferred to CMS?

A: CMS will be receiving provider and pharmacy data supplied for all individual (i.e., not employer-only) MA plans, including:

- Local Coordinated Care Plans (CCP) - HMO, HMO-POS, and Local Preferred Provider Organization (PPO)
- Regional PPO plans
- Medical Savings Account (MSA) network-based plans
- Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) network-based plans

Data Transfer Questions

Q: Will FHIR endpoints be exposed to support data transfer?

A: **In Phase 2**, FHIR endpoints will not be exposed to CMS to allow them to access the provider data. Instead, a URL will be placed in HPMS, that when crawled, will allow CMS to access pre-processed FHIR-based JSON files.

Q: Will the URL(s) provided by Kyruus ever change?

A: At this time, Kyruus does not expect the URL(s) to change. If they were to change advance communication would occur.

Q: How frequently will the URL(s) be crawled by CMS?

A: CMS will crawl the URL(s) per contract id daily and present validation results on a similar cadence.
