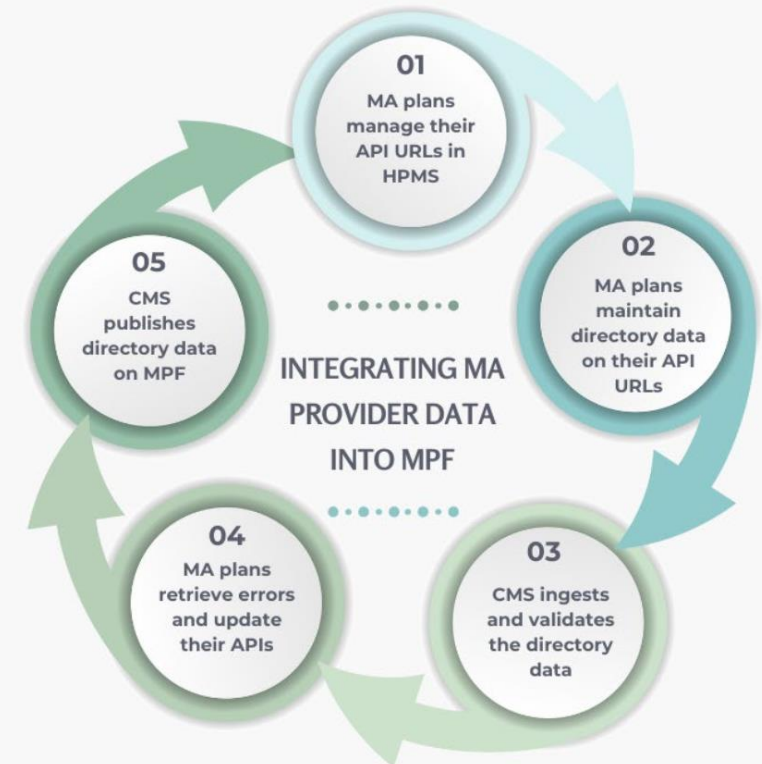

# Program Overview

# What is Medicare Plan Finder Phase II?

- As part of final rule CMS-4208-F2, all payers who offer Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans must supply provider directory data for all individual MA plans to CMS for display in Medicare Plan Finder (MPF) **beginning with Contract Year (CY) 2027**.
- Data will be supplied to CMS, leveraging either **Machine Readable JSON Files or FHIR-Based JSON Files**.
- These files are made available to CMS via an MPF Provider Directory URL defined in a payer's Health Plan Management System (HPMS) which **CMS will crawl and validate the data daily**. This URL is defined on a per CMS contract number/contract year basis.
- Plans will be responsible for **ensuring accuracy** of the provider data and must **attest to its accuracy annually within their HPMS system**.

July 10, 2026 (communicated June 24, 2026)	Populate MPF Provider Directory URLs in HPMS
September 1, 2026	Deadline for completing the CY 2027 attestation in HPMS
Early September 2026	Plan preview window
September 18, 2026	"Target" deadline for 10/1 production-ready CY 2027 data to be available.
October 1, 2026	Production release of the CY 2027 Medicare Plan Finder (MPF)

## MPF Provider Directory URL

### CMS Rule

Medicare Plan Finder Phase II (CMS-4208-F2), Technical Implementation Guide for Supplying MA Provider Directory Data for Use in MPF (published May 1, 2026).

### Call to Action

Report the public URL hosting your index file for each contract number / year in HPMS by July 10, 2026 — required even if the underlying JSON files are not yet complete.

### Access in HPMS

Open the “Manage MPF Provider Directory URLs” page in the MPF Provider Directory module.

### RevSpring Product Support

This is supported as part of the standard Provider Directory licensing with RevSpring



## FHIR Provider Directory API Endpoint

### CMS Rule

Interoperability & Patient Access final rule (CMS-9115-F, May 2020) — requires FHIR-based provider directory APIs using the HL7 FHIR standard.

### Call to Action

Enter your FHIR server base URL only for each contract number in HPMS by July 10, 2026. CMS must be able to access it without a client registration requirement.

### Access in HPMS

Open the “Manage FHIR Provider Directory API Endpoints” page in the MPF Provider Directory module.

### RevSpring Product Support

This is supported for clients who license our Provider Directory FHIR API

# RevSpring Action Plan

## Supporting MPF Provider Directory URLs

**RevSpring** has taken the following actions to support the July 10th deadline from CMS

### **Generated MPF Provider Directory URLs for clients in active MPF Support**

- All clients in active testing (provided requested crosswalk) have received MPF Provider Directory URLs per contract ID/contract year for entry into HPMS
- All clients who have at least provided Medicare Contract ID, Plan ID, and Plan Segment have received MPF Provider Directory URLs per contract ID/contract year for entry into HPMS

### **Actively Supporting Testing Feedback from the CMS Validation Process**

- Clients in active testing are working with RevSpring to resolve validation feedback from CMS through August testing window

### **RevSpring Compliance Support**

- MPF Phase II is included as part of the standard Provider Directory offering for RevSpring clients

# What is CMS-9115-F – Interoperability and Patient Access

Published: May 1, 2020

Enforced: July 1, 2021



## The Big Picture

Health plans share their provider directory through a secure FHIR API – so care coordination is easier for members and 3<sup>rd</sup> party apps, making the effort to find in-network doctors without authentication barriers



## Who Needs to Comply

Medicare Advantage, Medicaid and CHIP Managed Care plans, and State Medicaid agencies. Marketplace (QHP) issuers are exempt from this requirement.



## What You Need to Share

A public Provider Directory API with each provider's name, NPI, specialty, address, phone, and network affiliations – built on HL7 FHIR R4 / Da Vinci PDex Plan-Net standards.

# RevSpring Action Plan

## Supporting FHIR Provider Directory URLs

**RevSpring** recommends the following actions to support the July 10th deadline from CMS

### **Clients who have opted-in for MPF support and license RevSpring's FHIR Provider Directory API Service**

- Enter the existing Base FHIR URL into HPMS
- RevSpring has received confirmation that if the FHIR base URL applies to multiple contract numbers, please report the same FHIR base URL for all contract number entries

### **Clients who have opted-in for MPF support and do not license RevSpring's FHIR Provider Directory API Service**

- In principle, your organization should already maintain a compliant end point under that rule.
- If you do not, RevSpring can help you get there, though candidly not in time for July 10. RevSpring's FHIR Provider Directory API Endpoint offering gives you a fully managed FHIR endpoints **built directly on your provider directory data.**

### **RevSpring Compliance Support**

- RevSpring offers a FHIR Provider Directory API add-on service, that will meet the FHIR Provider Directory URL request

No login or app registration – secure short-lived tokens, GET-only, with no consumer tracking.

## One Simple Data Feed

Send data once; RevSpring transforms it to FHIR and absorbs future updates – no feed changes.



## Developer-Ready

A conformant CapabilityStatement lets apps automatically discover everything they need.

## CMS Is Raising the Bar — And the Deadline

In 2026 and coming years, CMS is making a concerted effort to improve how healthcare data is made available across the ecosystem. Their focus is to ensure that consumers, you and me, have **access to accurate and actionable data** to make informed decisions when making care decisions. Inaction will lead to suppression of data and potentially escalating penalties.

## WHAT WE'RE ENABLING



### CMS-0057-F Provider Directory API

Public, no-auth FHIR R4 directory meeting the Jan 1, 2027 compliance deadline. NPI-validated data updated within 30 days — built to pass CMS secret-shopper accuracy audits.



### Provider FHIR Directory up to Federal and State Standards

Expanded data fields that provide more actionable information to provider data. Enabling uses of the FHIR API to provide more accurate information to their users.



### Setup for Success with Future Mandates

CMS is looking towards a National Provider Directory, and FHIR is their path forward. With this support, RevSpring will be able to ensure future compliance can be easily achieved.

## Key Actions and Deadlines

Action items and deadlines to keep Medicare Plan Finder Phase II work on track:

### **Data Submission & Validation**

- Submit CMS feedback (validation reports) to support
- Submit production level data by 8/15 via email
- Submit CMS feedback (production level validation reports) to support

### **Production URLs & HPMS**

- Provide any updated data to RevSpring as soon as possible so it can be incorporated into the September 18th deadline
- RevSpring to distribute production URLs; if there is a new contract, a new URL will be shared
- Upload new URL to HPMS before 9/18
