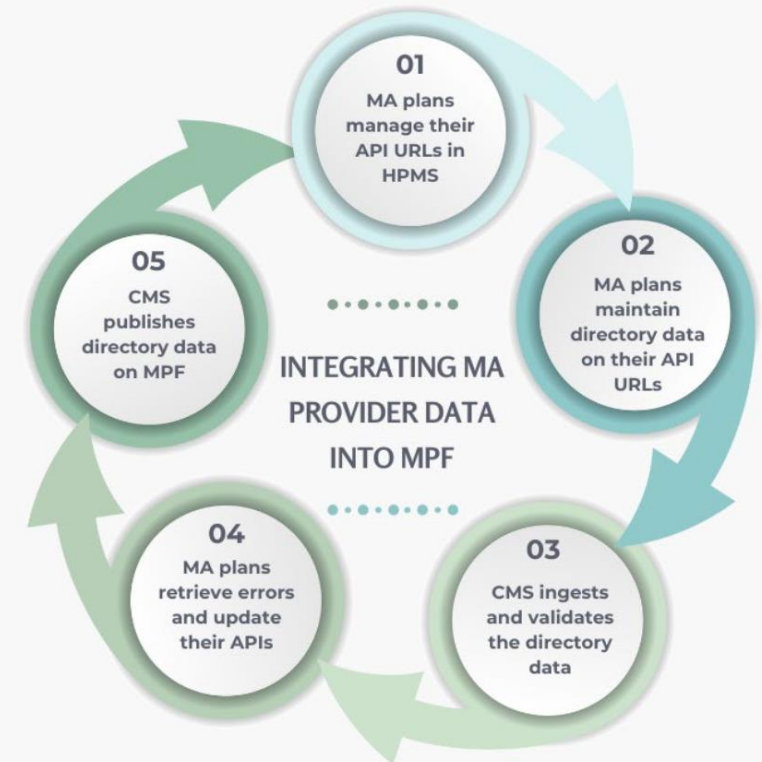

Program Overview

What is Medicare Plan Finder Phase II?

- As part of final rule CMS-4208-F2, all payers who offer Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans must supply provider directory data for all individual MA plans to CMS for display in Medicare Plan Finder (MPF) **beginning with Contract Year (CY) 2027**.
- Data will be supplied to CMS via **FHIR-Based JSON Files**.
- These files are made available to CMS via an MPF Provider Directory URL defined in a payer's Health Plan Management System (HPMS) which **CMS will crawl and validate the data daily**. This URL is defined on a per CMS contract number/contract year basis.
- Plans will be responsible for **ensuring accuracy** of the provider data and must **attest to its accuracy annually within their HPMS system**.

May – August 2026	Plan testing period using machine-readable JSON files and FHIR-based API files
July 10, 2026 (communicated June 24, 2026)	Populate MPF Provider Directory URLs in HPMS
September 1, 2026	Deadline for completing the CY 2027 attestation in HPMS
September 18, 2026	“Target” deadline for 10/1 production-ready CY 2027 data to be available.
October 1, 2026	Production release of the CY 2027 Medicare Plan Finder (MPF)

Production Cutover Steps

What You Need to Do Before Go-Live

Target window: August 15 – September 18, 2026

Submit Your Finalized CY2027 Data

Share your finalized CY2027 network crosswalk with RevSpring as soon as it's available.

Enter Your Production URL in HPMS

Once RevSpring provides your production MPF Provider Directory URL, enter it on the “Manage MPF Provider Directory URLs” page.

Complete Your Annual Attestation

Attest to the accuracy of your CY2027 data in HPMS by September 1, 2026.

Share Any CMS Validation Findings

Let us know about any issues from CMS validation so we can help resolve them quickly.

Known Issues

MPF Phase II Provider Directory URL Submission

We're currently tracking three known issues affecting MPF Phase II URL submissions:

CMS OmittedContractID Error

Confirmed by CMS as a known bug affecting some submitted index files; CMS is releasing fix this Friday 7/24.

HPMS URL Submission Errors

Some clients are seeing save or validation errors when entering URLs in HPMS; root cause is under investigation with CMS.

URL Access-Validation Message

A validation message can appear at submission even when a URL is valid and reachable; CMS has confirmed it does not block crawling.

We'll continue to keep you updated as CMS provides more information.

Provider Directory URLs Summary

What is CMS-9115-F – Interoperability and Patient Access

Published: May 1, 2020

Enforced: July 1, 2021



The Big Picture

Health plans share their provider directory through a secure FHIR API – so care coordination is easier for members and 3rd party apps, making the effort to find in-network doctors without authentication barriers



Who Needs to Comply

Medicare Advantage, Medicaid and CHIP Managed Care plans, and State Medicaid agencies. Marketplace (QHP) issuers are exempt from this requirement.



What You Need to Share

A public Provider Directory API with each provider's name, NPI, specialty, address, phone, and network affiliations – built on HL7 FHIR R4 / Da Vinci PDex Plan-Net standards.

RevSpring FHIR Provider Directory API

Going beyond CMS-9115-F Provider Directory requirements – and what that means for you



Standards-Conformant

Conforms to HL7 FHIR R4 and Da Vinci PDex Plan-Net, supporting all eight Plan-Net profiles.

All Required Data – and More

Every CMS-mandated field, plus extras like credentials, languages, and geo-coordinates.



Public, No-Login Access

No login or app registration – secure short-lived tokens, GET-only, with no consumer tracking.



Ready for Every Plan & Brand

A scoped endpoint per payer and brand, so one deployment covers all your plans.



One Simple Data Feed

Send data once; RevSpring transforms it to FHIR and absorbs future updates – no feed changes.



Developer-Ready

A conformant CapabilityStatement lets apps automatically discover everything they need.

CMS Is Raising the Bar — And the Deadline

In 2026 and coming years, CMS is making a concerted effort to improve how healthcare data is made available across the ecosystem. Their focus is to ensure that consumers, you and me, have **access to accurate and actionable data** to make informed decisions when making care decisions. Inaction will lead to suppression of data and potentially escalating penalties.

Stay Ahead of the Mandates

RevSpring is already building what CMS will require.

WHAT WE'RE ENABLING



CMS-0057-F Provider Directory API

Public, no-auth FHIR R4 directory meeting the Jan 1, 2027 compliance deadline. NPI-validated data updated within 30 days — built to pass CMS secret-shopper accuracy audits.



Provider FHIR Directory up to Federal and State Standards

Expanded data fields that provide more actionable information to provider data. Enabling uses of the FHIR API to provide more accurate information to their users.



Setup for Success with Future Mandates

CMS is looking towards a National Provider Directory, and FHIR is their path forward. With this support, RevSpring will be able to ensure future compliance can be easily achieved.

Key Actions and Deadlines

Action items and deadlines to keep Medicare Plan Finder Phase II work on track:

Data Submission & Validation

- Submit CMS feedback (UAT validation reports) to support
- Submit production level data by 8/15 via email
- Submit CMS feedback (production level validation reports) to support

Production URLs & HPMS

- Provide any updated data to RevSpring as soon as possible so it can be incorporated into the September 18th deadline
- RevSpring to distribute production URLs; if there is a new contract, a new URL will be shared
- Upload new URL to HPMS before 9/18
